The Autism Project is a full time course; students attend between 9am-4pm, Monday to Friday, for 36 weeks.



The aim of the course is to get students “work ready”.



Students spend four days a week in the workplace and complete up to three work experience placements during the academic year.

City & Guilds



Students also attend class every Thursday where they study a City & Guilds Employability Skills Award.



Students learn skills such as CV writing, how to apply for jobs and appropriate communication. It also gives opportunities for socialising.



Most placements are based in Guy's and St. Thomas' Hospitals in various departments.
